Wildfires – OR and WA

Several wildfires have continued to grow and spread across the state of Oregon and Washington. States-wide, wildfires have burned more than a million acres. Although FEMA has yet to make a federally-declared disaster declaration, certain areas in Oregon and Washington counties are at risk. As a preemptive measure due to uncertainty of the massive wildfires, Impac is temporarily ceasing funding in the following counties and zip codes:
