SCU Lightning Complex Fire – CA

The SCU Lightning Complex started on August 16 with multiple fires within the complex. It has burned about 391,578 acres with 78% containment as of Thursday, September 3, 2020. Although FEMA has yet to make federally-declared disaster declarations, certain counties in Bay Area, CA are at risk. As a preemptive measure due to uncertainty of the massive wildfire, Impac is temporarily ceasing funding in the following counties and zip codes:

- <u>Alameda Danger Zip Codes:</u> 94539, 94550, 94586
- <u>Contra Costa Danger Zip Codes:</u> 94513, 94517, 94551, 94588
- <u>Santa Clara Danger Zip Codes:</u> 94550, 95020, 95035, 95038, 95127, 95132, 95135, 95138, 95140, 95148
- San Joaquin Danger Zip Codes: 95376, 95377
- <u>Stanislaus Danger Zip Codes:</u> 95313, 95360, 95363, 95387

We will re-evaluate in the coming days and make further determinations from there.
