Subject: FHFA Directed National Pricing Changes – New Impac Rate Sheet Adjustments

The Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA) has directed Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac to change certain loan level price adjustments (LLPAs). Impac Mortgage Corp. will be implementing these changes for both Fannie and Freddie programs **commencing with locks on or after Wednesday, July 15, 2015.**

The new LLPAs will be reflected on the July 15th rate sheet.

A summary of the changes is listed below:

- Increases in the LLPAs charged for mortgage loans with terms greater than 15 years based on the credit score and LTV ratio (changes are highlighted, LLPAs increased by .25);

- Changes in the LLPAs charged for mortgage loans with certain product features, such as
 - Investment properties
 - Increase by .375 for all LTVs (including HARP)
 - Cash-out refinances
 - Increase by .375 for all cash-out mortgages
 - High-balance/Super conforming mortgage loans
 - Increase by .25 for purchase and rate/term mortgages (including HARP)
 - Mortgage loans with subordinated financing (excluding Community Seconds and Affordable Seconds)
 - Increase by .375 all mortgage loans with non-affordable program secondary financing (including HARP)
