Hurricane Harvey – Texas and Louisiana
August 25, 2017

Because of the impact Hurricane Harvey is projected to have on the Texas coast and potentially on the southern parts of Louisiana, Impac is suspending funding loans in the locations shown below until the hurricane weakens, and loans with appraisals completed prior to today's date may require a recertification. .

Texas has declared a state of disaster for 30 counties: Aransas, Austin, Bee, Brazoria, Calhoun, Chambers, Colorado, DeWitt, Fayette, Fort Bend, Galveston, Goliad, Gonzales, Harris, Jackson, Jefferson, Jim Wells, Karnes, Kleberg, Lavaca, Liberty, Live Oak, Matagorda, Nueces, Refugio, San Patricio, Victoria, Waller, Wharton, Wilson

Louisiana parishes potentially affected: Cameron, Iberia, Jefferson Davis, Lafourche, Orleans, Plaquemines, Saint Bernard, Saint Charles, Saint James, Saint John the Baptist, Saint Martin, Saint Mary, Saint Tammany, Terrebonne, Vermilion

Note that the suspension of funding loans or recertification requirements for these locations may not be lifted until next week. Further, until the Hurricane Harvey threat has diminished, closing documents will not be prepared.
