

The National Hurricane Center projects that the threat of direct impact from Hurricane Irma in Florida over the upcoming weekend and early next week has increased. Mandatory evacuations have been issued for Monroe and Miami-Dade County. Forecasters project that Irma will likely move up the East Coast; please be on the watch for Coastal Georgia and Coastal South Carolina. Based on the latest forecast from NHC showing the projected path of the storm, Impac is suspending releasing closing documents and funding loans in the locations shown below at this time.

Florida counties: Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Monroe, Collier, Martin

Note that suspension of releasing closing document and funding loans or recertification requirements for these locations may not be lifted until more definitive information has been provided by FEMA. Updates will be provided as more information becomes available.
